Supported Independent Living (SIL) includes:

- 24/7 support to assist residents to achieve their goals and greater independence
- Assistance with personal care, such as showering, dressing, and toileting
- Assistance with household tasks, such as preparing meals, washing clothes and cleaning
- Support with medical administration and specialist or medical appointments
- Assistance with everyday activities outside of the home, such as grocery shopping, going out for a meal, going out for a walk, transportation to participate in the community, and access services.

At our homes:

- All in-home SIL service is provided by CPA. For services outside of SIL hours, residents can use CPA or their preferred providers
- Residents' family and friends are welcome
- Residents' independence and inclusion are supported in household and community activities
- Residents receive personalised support with meal planning and preparation
- Residents have support 24/7 with staff awake overnight.
