Healthy ageing for adults with cerebral palsy

Are you an adult (30 years old or over) with cerebral palsy?

We are seeking adults with cerebral palsy (CP) to participate in a research project about healthy ageing with CP

What is this project about?

This research will explore and understand the ageing experiences of adults with cerebral palsy (CP), or across Australia and New Zealand.

What would be involved?

Participation involves completing a simple questionnaire (~15-20min) and an interview (~1 hour).

Interviews can be adapted to suit you and your communication needs.

What are the questions about?

The **questionnaire** asks general information about you and your health.

The **interview** will be a discussion about your experiences in ageing so far with CP, your needs and what healthy ageing means to you.

You will receive a voucher as a thank you.

Contribute to new knowledge!

This is a great opportunity to share your experiences so far, which will contribute valuable new knowledge about healthy ageing with CP.

This study has been approved by the Northern A Health and Disability Ethics Committee on 12 Feb 2024 for 3 years (reference 18972) and Curtin University School of Allied Health (HRE2024-0097).
