Cerebral Palsy Alliance, Sunnyfield and the Northern Beaches Council are starting early talks about our site at Allambie Heights.

These talks are in the very early stages.

No decisions have been made yet.

Planning will take several years.

What is being talked about?

We are talking about how the neighbouring land and buildings at Allambie Heights could be used in the future.

This might include new homes being built on the land.

If this happens, CPA will use the money from selling the land to:

- Build better, and more accessible offices for people to work, and for therapy and community services.
- Make sure CCPA is strong and safe for the future.

We know people in the Northern Beaches care a lot about trees, parks and green spaces.

Any plan will try to **respect the local area** and help the whole community.

Will my services move?

Nothing is changing now.

And it is okay to feel worried or upset about this news.

We will listen to you.

Your services will continue for now with no changes, for many years to come.

How long will this take?

Any big change will take a long time. Planning will take several years.

There will be **no sudden changes**.

How will we keep you updated?

We will:

1. Start group meetings in the future. These meetings will be in person and online.
2. Explain what is happening.
3. Answer your questions and listen to your ideas.

After each meeting, we will summarise what you said and what we will do.

We will also:

- Send you letters or emails with news.
- Put information on our website called “Allambie Discovery Project”.

Can I help make decisions?

Yes. Your input will help decide:

- Where the new site for therapy and community programs should be.
- What the new buildings should have.
